Leo Primus 2009 QOF Scholarship Recipient

Leo was awarded a QOF scholarship in his vocation of Project Management and he travelled to Malaysia, Thailand and Singapore to work on a major infrastructure project. Leo was a part of a \$6 billion dollar rail project connecting Thailand in the north with Singapore in the south. During his scholarship experience, he was responsible for \$380 million dollars worth of construction works, over 150 personnel from five different countries and a number of consultants spanning South-East Asia, Japan, Germany and Italy. On his return to Queensland he was hired as a Development Manager for AV Jennings and he has continued to work on an impressive list of projects in Queensland.

"I learnt to problem solve, communicate and adapt to a foreign place and foreign experiences. Money can't buy these experiences but they have all proven invaluable."

"After getting through the challenges of tunneling in a remote Malaysian jungle, there are not too many challenges I am not capable of working through today – personal or professional."
